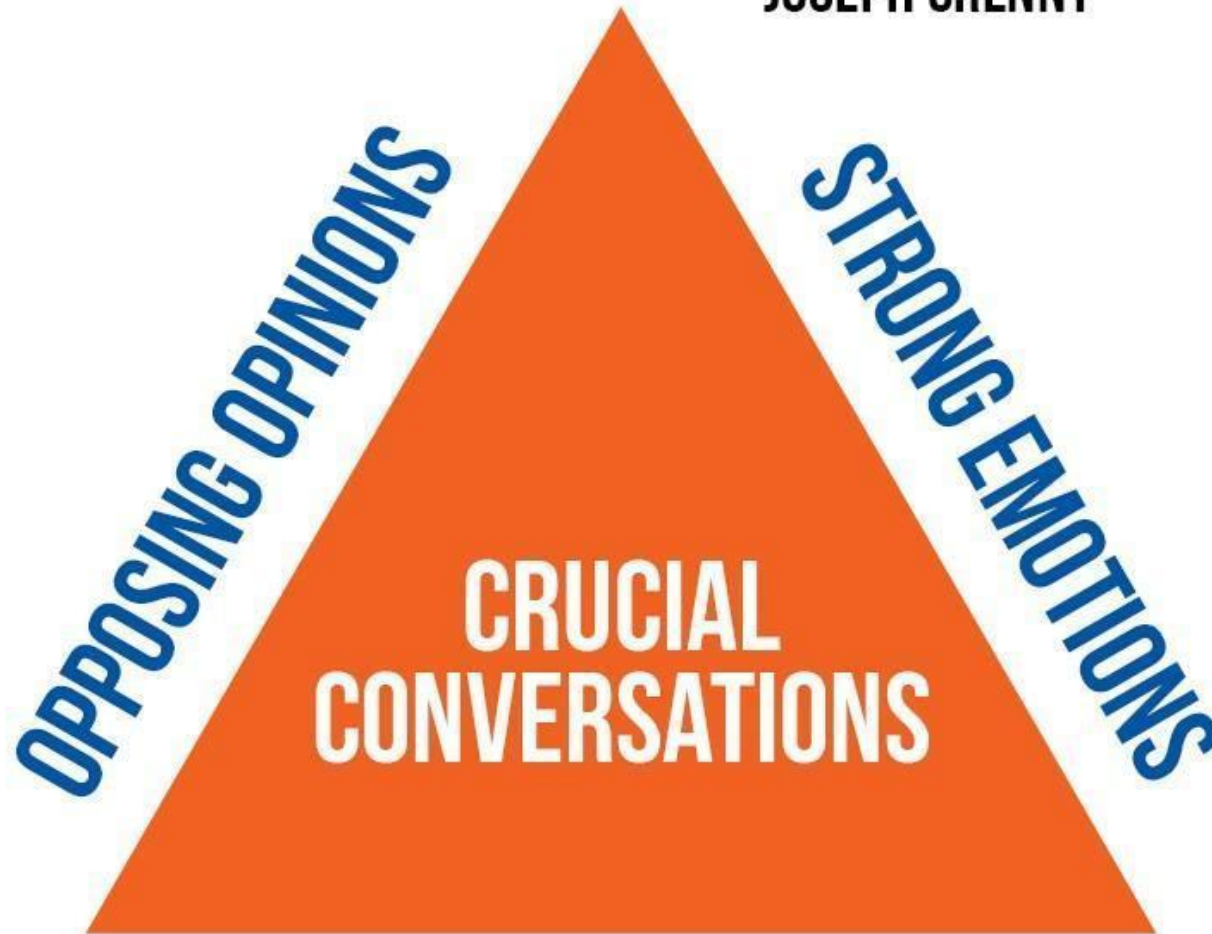

This sickens me... Paula dean always jumping in pictures with black folk... You no she went home and took a bath....

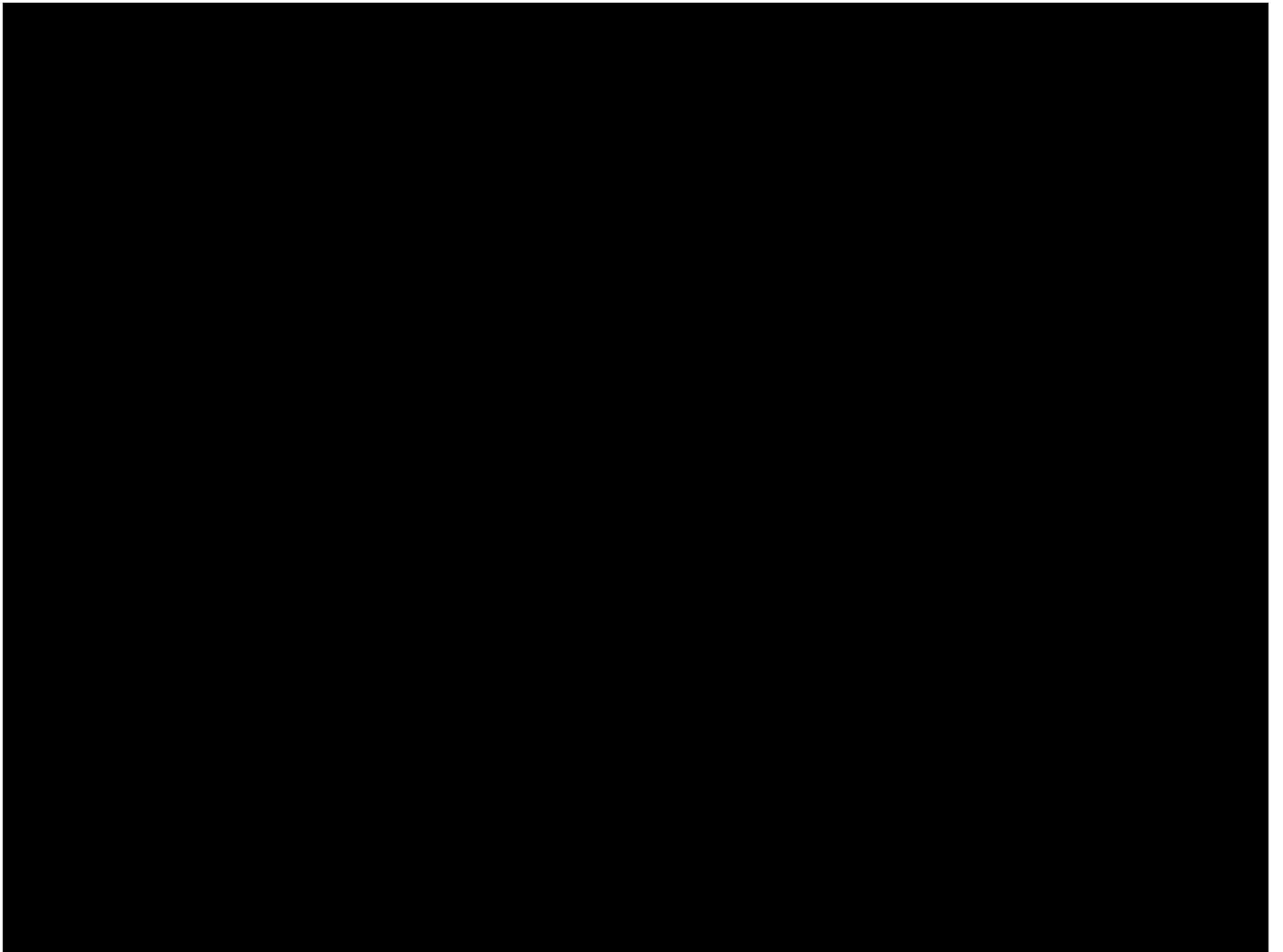
I can see straight through this
